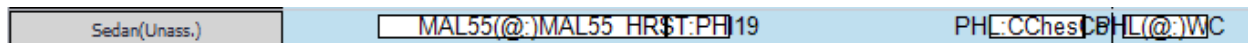

LiveryCoach.net Please note that in this and future Tech Tips, the screen shots and descriptions will all be from LiveryCoach.net, the new version of Livery Coach. Some of the tips we mention will also apply to the older “VB6” version. We will try to point out which tips only apply to LiveryCoach.net. If you aren’t already running LiveryCoach.net, please contact support@liverycoach.com to schedule your update. Note that there will be no more enhancements to Livery Coach VB6, and support will end at the end of this year.

Trip Schedule

One of the signature features of Livery Coach is the Trip Schedule screen (that big bar graph showing trips as horizontal bars). While we are the first to admit that some of you pretend this screen does not exist, many others of you don’t understand how you can schedule without it.

One of the difficulties that tripped up some people is that before you dragged the trips down into the vehicles, all the trips would be piled on top of each other, which looked like a mess.



In LiveryCoach.net, there is an option that allows you to not have all these bars overlap. When this box is checked, then the height of the vehicle row will dynamically expand to fit all the bars—so you can see exactly what is there.

Simply click on the Config button at the top right of the Trip Schedule screen, and then check the box labeled “No Bar Overlap”.
