Tech Tip is back!

We are continuing to work on enhancements and additions to the Livery Coach suite of products, which will be the subject of future tech tips. Some of the enhancements either already complete or on the near-term roadmap that we will be talking about in future tech tips include:

- Auto-Close – trips that meet your criteria can be closed in TripBook without human intervention
- ELD (Electronic Driver Log) integration—coming this fall (with go.keeptruckin.com)
- Web Booking Portal—Zero Resistance booking
- iGroup—allows your meeting planners to have a dynamic group manifest with chauffeur info and GPS tracking
- GRiDD Integration—send and receive trips from other systems. Are you connected yet?
- Map-based rate zones—draw your zones on a map rather than entering sets of cities/states/zips
- ETA tracking—the system will track your trips and give you advance warning if a chauffeur appears to be running late
