GRiDD/GNet update

To those of you who attended the GRiDD/GNet update meeting in Orlando, thanks! In case you have forgotten, GNet is an independent network that facilitates the electronic transmission of trips from/to different software platforms. It supports the return of driver info and GPS, and more features are being added.

GNet functionality is built in to Livery Coach and does not require any module purchase. In addition, Livery Coach does not charge any fees for use of the network.

Other software providers that currently support GNet include FastTrak Cloud, Hudson, and LimoAnywhere (for receiving trips only—send is coming later)

The good news is that more software platforms are rapidly signing on, including Ground Alliance, DashRide, and Latitude247 (New Zealand). In addition, another software company (to be named soon) committed at the show to begin the integration shortly. We believe this is a good step for the industry.
