Who's logged in to my system right now? What modules do I have?


Have you ever tried to log in to Livery Coach and gotten a "too many users" message? Or, have you ever been a little unsure about what modules you have or don't have?

Your system can show you this information at a glance.

Simply navigate to Help... About Livery.



In addition to the "What's New?" tab, the "Purchased Features" tab shows what modules you have, and how many user licenses you have. Additionally, if you have any temporary rented licenses, you will see that here too, as well as when they expire.



The "Active Users" tab shows you how many people are currently logged in to the system, and if you click on the tab, you can see their Livery Coach user name, the Computer Name, when they logged in, how long they have been logged in, and what version of who is logged in to the system. (Note: if you see someone on an older version than everyone else, it means they are not accepting the updates, which is not recommended! Please take the updates!)
