

Tech Tip Tuesday—June 5, 2018

Bulk Security Edit

In a previous Tech Tip (back in July 2014, if anyone is keeping track), we talked about Maintain..Security and how you could see who had what permissions.

What we didn't talk about back then, because it didn't yet have the feature, is the fact that you can now grant (or remove) these permissions in bulk.

Navigate to Maintain...Security (assuming you have permission) and select the "Search Security Option" tab.


You can then select a feature from the column on the left, and either show who has the feature "Enabled", or "Disabled". In the screen shot below, we have selected "PA-DSS Reveal Masked Credit Card", which gives a user to see the full credit card number in a reservation.

In our test system you can see that very few users have it Enabled, and most of the users have it Disabled.




