LIVERY COACH IS NOW INTEGRATED WITH MOBILE TEXT ALERTS

We are pleased to announce that, in addition to our existing integration with Textline, we have now added an integration to Mobile Text Alerts, which is the SMS provider used by Santa Cruz clients.

GroundWidgets has negotiated special rates for Santa Cruz clients which are now being extended to all Livery Coach clients. Pricing is less expensive than Textline, and they solve the issues of SMS to different countries by using different local numbers where required.

GROUNDXCHANGE IS COMING TO LIMOANYWHERE

Since we're all part of the same family, LimoAnywhere is in the final stages of completing integration with GroundXchange for farming out trips. With GNet's recent price increase to \$1.50/trip, GroundXchange at \$1.25/trip is now cheaper than GNet.

We have finished tweaking the Livery Coach GroundXchange to work with LimoAnywhere, and so far in our testing (with a real Livery Coach customer and a real LimoAnywhere customer) everything is working well. Santa Cruz also currently has a small number of customers actively farming trips to a few selected LimoAnywhere operators during this testing phase.

If you'd like to be part of the testing group, please reach out to our support team with a list of a few LimoAnywhere customers you farm to, and we can help coordinate this with the folks at LimoAnywhere and get this set up. It's expected that this will be officially announced to the LimoAnywhere community at the CD/NLA Show at the end of October, so by starting now you can get ahead of the rush.
